New Container Program Coming Soon!

Your new 96-gallon recycling containers will be delivered the week of August 27th, 2018!
The new recycling program will begin September 1, 2018.

RECYCLING

Recycling is collected every other week on your regular waste day. Please place your recycling container at the curb the night before or by 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled day. The 18-gallon recycling container will no longer be serviced after September 1, 2018. If you no longer have a use for your old 18-gallon recycling container, you can place it in your new 96-gallon recycling container so that Republic Services® can recycle them.

Properly prepare your recyclables by rinsing and flattening (if possible). Do not bundle or bag. Plastic lids, bottle caps and labels are OK to leave on.

Yes! Put these items in your roll-out recycling container:

- All plastic bottles and containers (# 1 – # 7)
- Wide-mouth plastic containers & lids
- Rigid plastics
- Mixed paper, newspapers with inserts, junk mail
- Computer paper, office paper, color paper, envelopes
- Gift wrap paper (without foil backing)
- Magazines, telephone books, paperback books
- Cardboard, gift boxes, shoe boxes (flattened)
- Pizza, cereal & food boxes (no food debris)
- Milk & juice cartons & boxes (must be empty)
- Aluminum cans & steel cans including lids
- Aluminum foil (no food debris)
- Glass bottles & jars (all colors)
- Empty aerosol cans (no paint cans)



No! DO NOT put these items in your roll-out recycling container:

- Plastic bags, plastic film or wrap
- Yard waste, landscape debris, stone or rocks
- Styrofoam
- Waxed cardboard
- Rubber or tires
- Hazardous waste, electronics & paint
- Glassware, light bulbs, plate or window glass
- Clothing or fabric
- Household garbage or food waste
- Batteries
- Ropes, hoses, cords, tarps or wire

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Waste is collected every week on your current pick up day.
- **Recycling Day** - Recycling is collected every other week by Republic Services on your regular scheduled waste day. A recycling calendar will be distributed when the container is delivered.
- The recycling calendar corresponds to the week recycling is serviced on your regular waste day within the Town. Please reference the calendar for the highlighted recycling week.
- On your first recycling pick up day, you can place your old 18-gallon recycling container in your new 96-gallon recycling container so that Republic Services can recycle them.
- The 18-gallon recycling container will no longer be serviced effective September 1, 2018.

RECYCLING COLLECTION TIPS

The roll-out recycling collection program will result in a cleaner, more attractive environment as well as safer working conditions for our collectors. The new recycling collection system uses one type of container that will be emptied by automated equipment, making the process cleaner and safer. Wheeled containers make recycling collection easier for everybody. Containers are stable and designed to not blow over, even in high winds; lids are attached and snug-fitting to keep animals out, and containers also have a smooth interior, making cleaning easier.

To better service our customers, we ask you to please:

- Place your container(s) at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on the morning of or the night before your scheduled service.
- Place the container(s) within 3 feet of the curb with the handle and wheels facing away from the street.
- Make sure the container(s) is at least 4-5 feet from trees, mailboxes, cars, yard waste, utility poles or any other obstructions.
- Place all recyclable items in the Republic Services container for collection by our truck. Do not leave recyclables outside the roll-out container.
- Notify us if your container is damaged or stolen.
- Don't place construction debris, yard waste or hot ashes in the recycling container.
- Don't overfill the container; the lid must close.
- Don't pack recycling contents too tightly.
- Don't paint or write on the container.
- Don't remove the container from your residence.
- Don't put garbage/waste materials in the container marked RECYCLING.

WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT!



HELPFUL ANSWERS ABOUT YOUR SERVICES

- Your WASTE will be serviced one time per week by Republic Services; your RECYCLING container will be serviced by Republic Services every other week on your waste day.
- If you no longer have use for your old 18-gallon recycling container, you can place it your new 96-gallon recycling container so that Republic Services can recycle them.
- Your first collection day will be the week of September 10th, 2018. Service will continue every other week from then on. Please refer to your collection day schedule.
- The 18-gallon recycling container will no longer be serviced effective September 1, 2018.
- We operate on all holidays except Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
